WHAT DOES A CONSULTATION WITH YOU INVOLVE?

The consultation is the most critical element in establishing a great relationship with the patient. It provides the opportunity for the patient to meet me and my staff, and to first ask, "Am I going to be comfortable with these people providing my care?" Most patients have researched me through the Internet prior to coming in, so they know what my credentials are. Our consultation is simply about educating the patient on all the possibilities to enable them to make an informed decision on their proposed treatment. It is about giving the patient choices.

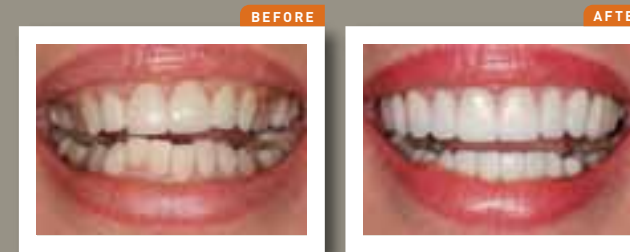
WHAT ACCOMPLISHMENT ARE YOU MOST PROUD OF?
